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MUSEV Pal Lab project's multiplier event was held in Ank consisting mostly of teachers. 34 participants attended the event, which took place on Thursday 24 September 2024 in the conference hall of Mamak Mimar Sinan Fine Arts High School. There was an exchange of ideas about how schools and teachers can benefit, especially in disadvantaged areas. Participants were asked to become a member of the platform and enroll the courses. The teachers examined the platform, which is also compatible with mobile phones, and gave generally positive feedback.

There were very interactive discussions on teachers' own experiences and the results of the project. High quality and productive comments were made around topics such as how the outputs can be used in schools, obstacles to the use of project results.

After brainstorming on how to further disseminate the project results and reach more people, the event ended with the evaluation questionnaire and certificate ceremony.












The answers from the evaluation questionnaire are positive. The participants evaluated the results in a high quality.























